

Building Blocks

"Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful." (Hebrews 9:24) When we reflect on the state of our world today, we can make one general observation: nothing is certain. Many things seems to be in flux or in danger of collapse. Social institutions and structures that we put in place to keep people from falling through the cracks are disappearing or have already been destroyed or deconstructed. What is a Christian to do in such situations?



Our author of the Letter to the Hebrews tells us to rely on another fruit of the Holy Spirit: faith! ---but not solely our faith in God, but God's faithfulness to each one of us! Yes, God knows we can still be that light shining in the darkness of sin! God is fully confident that we can still be led by the Holy Spirit to lift up a better vision for our world than the one it offers to us. God gives some of us leadership skills to help us do just that as a community of faith.

God is jubilant too, that his Son, Risen from the Dead, is able to offer the world a hope that, despite the worst that the world may have to throw at us, New Life is not only possible, but dependable and assured when it is deeply grounded in our faith in our Holy Redeemer, Jesus Christ our Lord! It is that hope, rooted in faith, that is able to bring us through the dark times and the uncertain times and the chaotic times, and allow us to adapt while still remaining fixed on the core values and vision of the Kingdom, not just for us, but for all people everywhere! This year of the jubilee of hope is perfectly timed for the moment we are living today! So let us remain hopeful because of Gods' faithfulness to us, and allow our faith in the Lord to have a significant impact on our response to the world around us. --- Fr Sam




his project's objective was to provide backpacks filled with personal items needed inthe heat for our homeless brothers and sisters who live on the streets.
