Nothing more than *Love and Grace!*

St. Paul is a little perturbed at the Corinthian community because the unity that they had once experienced in Christ has vanished and, in its stead, a jockeying for positions of prestige based on who baptized whom in the community. Paul therefore rhetorically asks, ***"Has Christ been divided? What Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?"***
(1 Cor 1: 13)

Some bragged about being baptized by Apollos. Some bragged that they were baptized by Cephas. Paul will have nothing to do with encouraging such divisions in the One Church of Christ. And so ecumenical challenges were there from the very start of the church community. It took leaders like Paul to call out the sins of disunity and to urge people to find their common bond in Christ once more. And that common bond was baptism. It took leaders like Paul to convince Christians that we have a lot more in common than what separates us from one another. Remember we just finished celebrating the 1700th anniversary of the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed, which is the basis for all the essentials of Christian faith.

We indeed share a lot together! We could use a lot more Pauls in our churches today though, who are unwilling to live with the status quo of hundreds of denominations and are willing to put in the hard work that leads to reunification! We could do with a lot more supporters of Paul's appeal to unity rather than division, so as to overcome our misunderstandings of other Christian denominations and for them to overcome their misunderstandings of us. We could use a lot more Christians in our churches today who are willing to make ecumenism a central part of their own mission in the Church, so as to restore the Unity of the Church which Christ intended. --- Fr Sam
