



BUILDING BLOCKS



In our second reading today from **1 Corinthians 1:27**, Paul asserts, “**But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong.**” Here, Paul is highlighting the divine paradox at the heart of the Christian faith: God’s power and wisdom are revealed through what the world considers insignificant or unworthy. In Paul’s view, God doesn’t operate according to human standards of strength, wisdom, or social status. Instead, God’s grace is often made manifest through those who are humble, overlooked, or marginalized.

We ourselves are not perfect people. We’re in the process of becoming that which God intends us to be. And the more we have to rely on God’s love and grace to get us there, the greater witness value our lives will have for those who have yet to believe and whom the Lord places along our life’s path.

Paul therefore wants us to trust in God’s providence and grace to lead us from A to B. What sometimes may get in the way of that progression is our human pride and our wanting to be self-sufficient and to go it alone. By choosing the “foolish” and the “weak,” however, God demonstrates that salvation and holiness are gifts freely given, not earned by worldly achievements or human intelligence. God therefore challenges us to value every person by recognizing the dignity and potential for holiness in all, including those whom society may have disregarded and to allow God’s grace to work in us, to accomplish that which he purposed for our lives. --- **Fr Sam**
