

BUILDING BLOCKS



Is God asking
you
to be *his*
light?

Jesus says, "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hidden." (Mt 5: 14)

Many of us may have had gecko pets in our classrooms in elementary school. I was amazed at how hard it was to find when it changed its skin color to blend into the wood and foliage that was in its terrarium. Even though that's a cool trick they can play, Christians are not meant to be geckos! We're meant to be the opposite, in fact! We're meant to stand out in the world for the values and virtues which Christ embodied in his own lifetime on earth and to be willing to suffer persecution and hardship when we stand up against worldly values that place profit over people, power over stewardship, one country over all the others. Light is a great image then for the Christian! Because light has both the properties of a particle and a wave, it's unpredictable and travels into every crack and crevice when it draws near.

It can't easily be captured or controlled either. In spiritual terms, light is full of the Presence of the Holy Spirit! It is meant to shed a light on sin, to dispel darkness and doubt, and to recall to us our baptismal consecration. As people of light, we can't hide God's love and grace or hoard it, just for ourselves. No, we must give God's love and grace freely to those who ask us for help and find ways to extend God's kingdom ever wider. What holds us back from being God's light is our proclivity to be a gecko--to blend in, to be unnoticeable, to be timid and shy when confronted with a threat to God's values. What holds us back is refusing to shine our light where it most needs to be shone. Where is God asking you to be his light? Ask for God's love and grace to witness to others there! --- **Fr Sam**
