

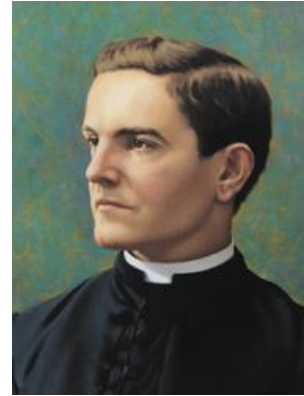

The Knights of Columbus venerate Fr. Micheal McGivney as the founder of our order. However, as our parish at Council 10888 is responsible for realizing the goals and values maintained through the works of the Redemptorists, we must also acknowledge the influence of Alphonsus Ligouri. Ligouri was an Italian bishop and saint, who is also recognized as a Doctor of the Church. He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists) in Italy in 1732. A main mission of the Redemptorists is to ...

"... invite people to a deeper love for God and a fuller practice of the Christian life." In accordance with the instructions of Ligouri, preaching is to be down-to-earth and understandable to all who are listening."

But, like the knights, Ligouri engaged in fighting for Christ. One of his other ministries included a fight against "[Jansenism](#), a heresy that preached an excessive moral rigorism: "the penitents should be treated as souls to be saved rather than as criminals to be punished" "

Fr. Sam has always provided insight into the missions and goals of Redemptorists through his homilies and direction of our parish. As Knights, we invite everyone to participate in adopting and realizing the goals and values of the Redemptorists as the best way for us to win for ourselves and our community as Knights of Columbus.

**Canada: Episcopal Ordination of the Most Rev. Fr. Michael Brehl C.Ss.R. at Pembroke, Ontario August 16, 2024**



On Thursday, August 15, 2024, on the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, **Michael Brehl C.Ss.R.**, Former Superior General, and Provincial Superior of the Province of Canada was consecrated as Bishop of the Diocese of Pembroke in Canada at St. Columbkille Cathedral (188 Renfrew Street, Pembroke, Ontario).

Surrounded by the support and prayers of the people of God, Bishop Michael was affirmed in his appointment by Bishops and Cardinals from the Redemptorist family, Redemptorists from Canada and around the world, his brothers, sisters and extended family, and parishioners and friends from Toronto and throughout Canada. Archbishop Marcel Damphousse, Archbishop of Ottawa-Cornwall, served as the Principal Consecrator, with Co-Concelebrants Archbishop Guy Desrochers C.Ss.R., Archbishop of Moncton, and Bishop Jon Hansen C.Ss.R., Bishop of Mackenzie-Fort Smith. Bishop Bryan Bayda C.Ss.R., of the Ukrainian Eparchy of Toronto and Eastern Canada, Bishop Michael Smolinski C.Ss.R., of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon, and Joseph Cardinal Tobin C.Ss.R. also joined the many Bishops and Cardinals in attendance.

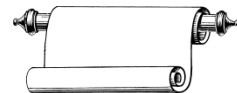
