The word that best encapsulates the feelings we're meant to have at Easter is **Alleluia!** In Hebrew, it literally means 'Praise the Lord!' So it's a good time to ask, what are we praising? We're praising the lengths to which God was willing to go to prove his love for us! We're praising Jesus' firm resolve to never step off the path that God had planned for his life, though at times it would have been far easier to take a less controversial path. We're praising Jesus' intimacy with the Father and Jesus' fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies as the Messiah. We're praising Jesus' promise of new life for all who believe and our adoption as God's sons and daughters---heirs to the Kingdom of God! We're praising Jesus' overflowing and never-ending mercy, whose Most Precious Blood, pouring forth from his wounds on the cross, forgave our sins and washed them away forever. We're praising that the burdens we've placed before the Lord in our Lenten Season have been accepted by God and that he will give us the grace to realize the New Life he offers us. We're praising Jesus' gift of faith to all who embrace his promise of salvation and the power that faith has to transform lives, our nation, our church and our world! We're praising that a New Creation has indeed begun and that God calls us to be stewards of the earth, protecting it for the next generation, and thus allowing all creation to sing 'Alleluia' to the Creator of All Things! We're praising the hope that each generation brings to the Church to continue Jesus' saving mission on earth! We're praising that all people everywhere are equally invited to be a part of God's kingdom – free of charge—and irrespective of nation, skin color, money, or position in society. We're praising that God has triumphed over the sin and death and has called out all the demonic forces in our world that choose to divide and judge as less than worthy, those who are powerless, without a voice, or unlike themselves. We're praising the eternal and unending love that God demonstrates by dying and then rising from the dead, and the subsequent love poured into our hearts which impels us to be his intentional missionary disciples. Yes, Easter is the best time to exclaim, **Alleluia** for these and many more reasons!

PPC - PARISH REPRESENTATIVE NEEDED

We are seeking a new parish representative at large (a two year commitment, renewable once), whose seat on the parish pastoral council will begin in the Fall of this year. The role of the Parish Representative at Large is to represent your needs or concerns at the parish council level.

If you know of someone whom you think might be able to faithfully fulfill this role, you can nominate them by picking up a nomination form at the help and information desk and asking them if they are willing to be nominated. If they agree, then bring back the form to the Help and Information Desk the following week.

The nominations will be vetted by the pastoral staff who will evaluate based on prior ministry position history, availability for meetings, and leadership skills. Those accepted will be contacted by Fr. Sam to ask if they are willing to let their name stand. Once acceptable nominations are closed, we will then allow the Holy Spirit to select the new representative at large by asking a parishioner to pick from a draw box, the name of the person who will take on this role.

"Packs for Hope"

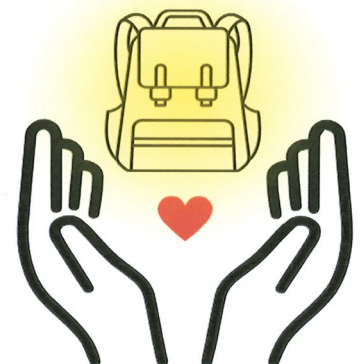
Reverse Collections Coming...

The "Great Sunday"

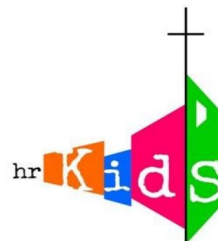
