This Sunday reminds us that even while we wait, we can be joyful. Advent is a time of hope and preparation. But this week, we pause to smile, sing, and take heart.

Why does the priest break off a piece of the host and drop it into the wine?



In the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, the priest first unites our hearts, minds, souls, and bodies by bringing us through space and time to the first Eucharist (the Last Supper), when Jesus would soon thereafter, have his body broken and his blood shed for the salvation of sinners. At mass, we are as if we were at the last supper with our Lord.

So during the mass, the bread is consecrated and becomes Jesus' body and the wine is consecrated and becomes Jesus' blood. But Jesus promised his disciples that death would neither be the end for him, nor for us. He promised that after three days, he would rise again! And so, when the priest breaks off a piece of the Host and drops it into the wine, this signifies that Jesus did not just die, but rose again, and when he rose again, his body and soul were reunited! Therefore, the unification of the bread and the wine signifies the resurrected, living Christ that we receive when we eat his body and drink his blood at mass and who comes to dwell among us in our hearts.
