

In the Roman Catholic Church, the role of a godparent (sometimes referred to as a sponsor) is both an honour and a responsibility. The Church's Canon Law sets out specific requirements for who can serve as a godparent for the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation.

Here are the Canonical Requirements (# 872 through 874):

- **1.** Age: The godparent must generally be at least 16 years old. However, the pastor may allow an exception for a just cause.
- **2.** Confirmation and Eucharist: A godparent must be a Roman Catholic who has received the sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist.
- **3.** Practicing the Faith: The godparent should lead a life in keeping with the Catholic faith and the responsibilities of the role.
- **4.** Not the Parent: The parent of the person being baptised or confirmed cannot serve as a godparent. However, step-parents may fulfill this role.
- **5.** Canonical Status: The godparent must not be bound by any canonical penalty (such as excommunication).
- **6.** Number of Godparents: For Baptism, there can be one godparent, or one godfather and one godmother. More than two godparents are not permitted officially. Unofficially, as some cultures have the tradition of having lots of godparents, you can select as many as you want. However, only one godmother and one godfather are recorded officially in the church registers.

Can a baptized Christian who is not Catholic serve as a godparent? The answer is no. However, such a person can serve as a Christian witness together with a Catholic godparent.

Can an unbaptized person serve as a godparent or witness? The answer is no, because they don't share the Christian faith into which the person is being baptized.

What if my chosen godparent can't be physically present at the baptism? Then a proxy stands in the person's place during the ceremony and the official godparent in recorded in the baptismal registry.

Since being a godparent is a significant spiritual commitment, the Canon Law of the Church is meant to ensure that the selected godparents are able to support the faith journey of the person they are sponsoring.
