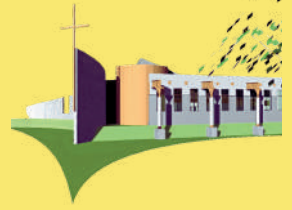

BUILDING BLOCKS

“THE GRACE OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST, THE LOVE OF GOD, AND THE COMMUNION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT BE WITH ALL OF YOU.”
(2 CORINTHIANS 13: 13)

This statement is one of the ways in which the early Christians would greet one another. Much longer than a 'hello' but also more revealing as to whom we owe our very lives. It comes down to Grace, Love and Communion. ---All three aspects of the life of the Holy Trinity whose concept was being formed in the mind, heart, and soul of St. Paul. It is this union of Father, Son and Holy Spirit which enables every thought, feeling and movement of God from the beginning of time! It is this union of Father, Son and Holy Spirit which creates the dynamism of God and the interplay between each member of the Godhead. It is this union of Father, Son and Holy Spirit which teaches us how to have authentic, life-giving, and profound relationships with one another and to help each other to find our way back to the source of all life. We do this by reflecting on the ways in which the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit have revealed themselves in scripture and also the ways in which they challenge us to live as sons and daughters of God, heirs to the Kingdom of heaven and of the promises made to us by Christ.

Consequently, the Holy Trinity pours out Grace on every person who asks for it. The unmerited Grace is the strength to accomplish that which God purposes for our lives. It gives us the ability to rely on the Almighty Power of God to accomplish great things in God's name. The Holy Trinity also pours out Love into the heart of every believer, so that they may know that they are indeed cherished by God 24/7 and have a reason to believe that God has their best interests at heart, even when, at times, tragedies may befall an individual and may challenge a believer's faith. The Holy Trinity also invites us to Communion with the Godhead, which reveals the closeness that God wants to establish with us and among us. Communion also implies being privy to God's desires for our lives and in directing the purpose of our existence at this very moment in time. It also enables us to build life-giving human relationships to sustain us along our pilgrim journey. So as we grow closer to the Holy Trinity, we grow in Grace, Love and Communion with God and begin to share in the divine life that God promises for all his faithful.--- Fr. Sam

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

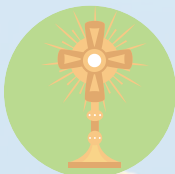
- Adoration ends on June 19th until after the long weekend in September.

The 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. Sunday morning Masses are cancelled until after the long weekend in September.

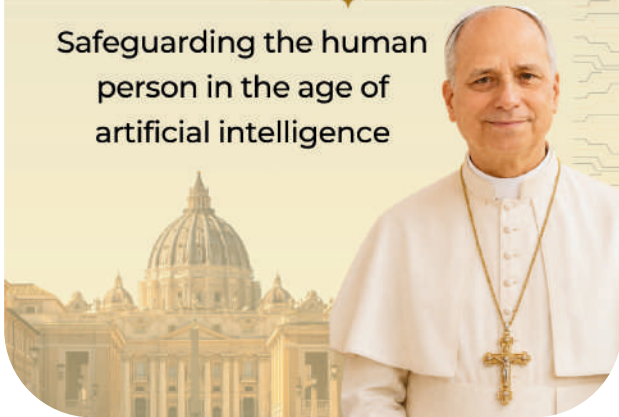

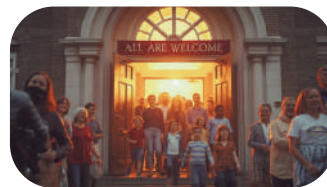

DID YOU KNOW?



Someone asked to explain the state of grace that one is to have, in order to receive communion.

A state of grace simply means that a person is not conscious of any unconfessed mortal sin. The action of the Holy Spirit can still be evidenced in the person's life. To commit a mortal sin, you have to have grave matter (that the act is seriously wrong), full knowledge (you know it is wrong), and deliberate consent (the choice to commit the sin is freely chosen.) In order to have a mortal sin forgiven, the sinner must celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation prior to receiving communion. Without receiving absolution, the sinner is barred from receiving communion. Venial sins (those that do not fit all three of the mortal sin criteria) can be forgiven in the penitential rite of the mass and therefore, the person is in a state of grace to receive communion.

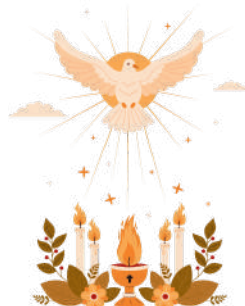
