DID YOU KNOW?



One parishioner asks, ***“How do I know if I’m doing or giving enough to God?”***

All of us have to ask this question to ourselves personally on a regular basis. The answer depends on an honest assessment of our life circumstances, our gifts and talents, our availability, and our receptivity to the voice of the Holy Spirit. Our receptivity to the voice of the Holy Spirit is good place to start. Take some time to ask God’s Holy Spirit to reveal to you what God desires for your life each day. Perhaps review your calendar with God every day and make a conscious effort to be present to the Lord in those events and in those people whom you will encounter.

When you sense a resistance to helping someone whom you could help, then ask the Holy Spirit for the courage to push through that resistance and to assist that person to the best of your ability.

Be realistic about your availability, too. All of us can carve out time to do some service for God or neighbor, if we’re serious about it. Evaluate too, what you’re good at and look for opportunities to share your gifts and talents in a ministry, an outreach, or a social project in the community. Sometimes it’s best to be proactive. Don’t wait for the opportunity to present itself to you. Actively seek out that which you know you have the skills and the talent to do. Invite God to give you a good assessment of your life circumstances too, so that you don’t take on too much and you don’t burn yourself out. Even Jesus took time away from others to recharge his spiritual batteries and give him a renewed sense of purpose. In summation, be open to the path God shows you this Lenten Season and see where it leads you. --- Fr Sam
